Drug facts

Composition: each 5 mL contains:

Ambroxol HCI.....15 m

Vehicle qs.

Indications and uses:

 Ambroxol is indicated as an expectorant and mucolitic in processes where increase of the fluidity of the respiratory tract secretions is required, as in bronchial asthma, various types of acute and chronic bronchitis, spasmodic bronchitia, bronchial asthma, bronquiectasia, pneumonia, bronchopneumonia, rhinitis, sinusitis, atelectasis by mucous obstruction, traqueostomy.

Dose

- · Do not administer to children under 2 years.
- Children 2 to 5 years: 1/2 teaspoon (2.5 mL) every 8 hours or dose recommended by your doctor.
- . Children 5 to 12 years: 1 teaspoon (5 mL) 2 or 3 times a day.
- Children over 12 years old and adults: 2 teaspoons (10 mL) 3 times a day for the first 2 days of treatment, after these two days 1 teaspoon (5 mL) 2 or 3 times a day.

Contraindications:

- . Hypersensitivity to any component of the formula.
- . Hypersensitivity to Ambroxol or Bromhexine.
- · Active peptic ulcer.
- · First trimester of pregnancy or breast-feeding.
- · Hepatic and renal impairment.

General precautions:

. This medicine should be used with caution in patients with gastrointestinal ulcer and in geriatric patients.

Adverse reactions:

 Rarely, severe anaphylactic reactions and skin adverse reactions (SCARs), including erythema multiform, Stevens Johnson syndrome/toxic epidermal necrolysis, and acute generalized exanthematous pustulosis, have been reported in patients receiving ambroxol.

Warnings:

 Consult your doctor before starting to use this medicine if you are pregnant or suspect that you are pregnant or while breast-feeding. It has not yet been established the safety of this drug for use during pregnancy and lactation so its use is not recommended in these states.

Route of administration: Oral.

Presentation: 120 mL bottle.

Storage conditions:

- . Keep in a cool and dry place (below 30°C), protect from light.
- · Medicine, keep out of reach of children.
